Conference Tours and Excursions

After the hard work at the conference, you will be given the opportunity to do a bit of sightseeing throughout the beautiful landscape around Opatija, the town often called the Nice of the Adriatic. It is one of the most popular tourist resorts in Croatia and a place with the longest tourist tradition on the eastern coast of the Adriatic. Some places of interest are:

Lungomare

The **12-km-long coastal promenade** joins up the main points along the Opatija Riviera - Volosko, Opatija, Ičići, Ika and Lovran. Undisturbed by traffic, this walk along the sea front presents a wonderful opportunity to escape the stresses of everyday life.

Tourist Bus

See the sights of Rijeka and Opatija with commentary in ten languages. Tickets can be bought at the Rijeka and Opatija Tourist Information Centers, in hotels in Rijeka and Opatija or on the tourist bus.

Učka Nature Park

Within only a couple of hours, any one of the park's numerous hiking trails will take you from the picturesque Mediterranean architecture of the coastal cities through the wooded slopes of Učka mountain up to its highest peak, Vojak, at a height of 1.401 meters. At the summit, a belvedere in the form of a medieval tower offers breath-taking view in all directions: the Istrian peninsula, the islands of the northern Adriatic, the mountains of Gorski kotar, Venice, the Italian Alps, etc.

Here you will find good opportunities for entertainment and many chances to try some of the culinary specialities based on chestnuts, asparagus and other local health-foods.









Plitvice Lakes National Park

Plitvice Lakes National Park is one of the greatest natural wonders of Europe. Embraced by high wooded mountains, one beneath another lie sixteen beautiful lakes of crystal blue-green water. Connected to each other by a series of foaming cascades and thundering waterfalls, the lakes are fed by many rivers and streams. Over the millennia, waters of these lakes have dissolved the limestone rock and carved out the valley in which they now lie.
