Manuscripts should be typed according to the guidelines in the Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association (7th Edition). Length of papers should normally be 5000 to 7000 words, while review articles may be longer in arrangement with the Editors.

Authors should submit an electronic version (Microsoft Word) of the manuscript (in English only) to the editorial office till **1<sup>st</sup> November 2021**.
